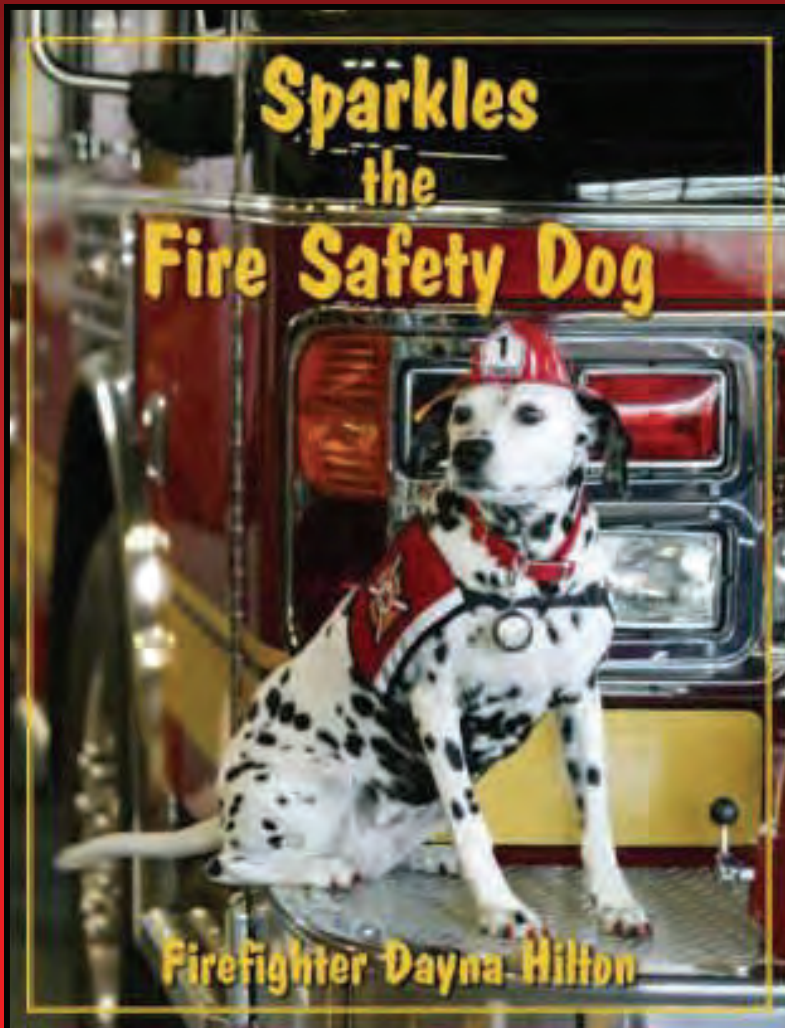

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Tell us about yourself.

A. I am a firefighter, fire safety educator, author of children's fire safety books and Executive Director of the Keep Kids Fire Safe Foundation. My Dalmatians, Sparkles the Fire Safety Dog, Spanner and Tango, assist with helping me teach fire safety. You can pretty much say that I live and breathe fire safety education and it is my sincere hope to help keep everyone fire safe.

In 2000, I joined the fire service. I became interested in fire safety education after attending a class at the National Fire Academy (NFA) in Emmitsburg, Maryland. It was at that time that I realized that my state (Arkansas) ranked seventh in the nation in fire-related deaths and injuries. While at NFA, I vowed to do whatever I could to help change those unfortunate statistics. Since then, I have made it my goal in life to help keep children and their caregivers fire safe throughout the United States.

The opportunity at the National Fire Academy opened my eyes and provided the foundation for everything that I am and do today. I am forever grateful to the academy, to my fire department, my Fire Chief, the firefighters on my department and to my mentor, Emily McGlaughlin, for helping make me the fire safety educator that I am today.

Q. What are the fire safety tips included in the book?

A. The fire safety tips include: (1) Recognizing the firefighter as a helper and a friend, (2) Knowing the sound and purpose of a smoke alarm, (3) Learning how to crawl low under smoke, and (4) Understanding the importance of practicing a home fire drill using an escape map. These are very critical fire safety messages for young children and their families to know and understand.

Author Dayna Hilton Frequently Asked Questions

Q. You produced a *Sparkles the Fire Dog* audio book that accompanies the book and features three generations of firefighters. What can you tell us about it?

A. The audio book is a perfect complement to the book and is designed to help children learn to read in addition to learning how to stay fire safe. One of the most popular audio book features is the bonus, "Sparkles' Theme Song." Children love hearing this song again and again. Three generations of firefighters worked on the audio book project including: my dad, Glenn Trembley, my son Michael, and me. Michael engineered the audio book and composed "Sparkles Theme Song."

Q. You recently learned that two children who were at one of your book readings and watched your fire safety presentation helped save their two families during a real life fire situation. Tell us more.

A. In November 2008, Sparkles and I went to Tulsa, Oklahoma to read our book and make a fire safety presentation for almost 450 students at Celia Clinton Elementary. Each child that day was given a copy of my book, *Sparkles the Fire Safety Dog*, courtesy of the Tulsa Rotary Club. Subsequently, I have learned that two children in the audience that day were involved in fire situations. Separately, both children volunteered that they knew what to do to get their families out of their homes because of what "Sparkles taught them." Indeed, Sparkles has made a significant impact on the lives of these two young children and their families through her fire safety demonstrations and the book. Not a day goes by that I don't think of these two young children and the positive impact Sparkles has made in their lives. Q. It must have been an amazing feeling when you found out that your book helped save lives.

A. The day that I received the phone call from Principal Davis is a day that I will never forget as long as I live. Since that day, Sparkles and I have made a trip back to Celia Clinton Elementary to meet the children and their families. It was truly amazing to hear the children's stories of how they were able to get their families out safely. Sparkles and I are both thankful that they are safe.

Q. Your book helps the Keep Kids Fire Safe Foundation, a foundation dedicated to helping provide fire safety materials at no cost to fire departments and other organizations. How does the book assist the foundation with its efforts?
